Its outstanding teaching, rigorous research and talented students keep it among the world's top universities year after year. Socially engaged, environmentally conscious and committed to the community, the Université de Montréal takes sustainable actions that benefit the city and the entire planet. Our *Department of Anesthesiology and Pain Medicine* has outstanding records and expertise in various domains such as pain medicine, education through simulation, focus echography, and cardiac anesthesia.

McGill University is one of Canada's best-known institutions of higher learning and one of the leading universities in the world. With students coming to McGill from some 150 countries, our student body is the most internationally diverse of any research-intensive university in the country. in 1945 Wesley Bourne established the first Canadian department of Anesthesia as well as the first diploma of Anesthesia at McGill University.
